Below is a list of the tools recommended for this Course. Students need not purchase any tools and are welcome to use PFW's hand tools. However, we have found that if students work with their own hand tools they have a better learning experience. The vendors, brands and models listed below are merely suggestions based upon the experience of PFW but by no means are the only high quality tools or vendors.

- Combination Square, 12" Starrett- Gradation 4R, Satin Chrome finish. We recommend the forged steel head.
