PFW has a wide assortment of hand tools for students to use. However, if you have your own tools or would like an excuse to purchase some new ones, the tool list is below with some recommendations. As a starting point, PFW can happily recommend purchasing tools from Tools for Working Wood, Lie-Nielsen Tool Works, Lee Valley/Veritas, Hida Japanese Tools and Hock Tools. There are many other good suppliers as well.

- Hammer or dead blow mallet for assembling the chair

- 1/8" mortise chisel
- Marking gauge
- Bevel square
- Tape measure
- Pencil and notebook
